Natural Gas Rate Increase

The Town is partnered with the Louisiana Municipal Gas Authority, a joint action agency comprised of 70 cities, parishes & gas districts across the state. The Town of Clinton owns and operates its own local gas distribution system.

As the result of an extensive gas rate study conducted by the LMGA Team, our gas rates must be increased. The Town of Clinton has not adjusted gas rates since 2005. Being that rates have not gone up and the price of everything has, as we all know, we must make enough to deliver this ever-important service to your home and/or business.

An ordinance was passed by the Board of Aldermen on May 10th to increase rates. We are introducing a slow progressive rate increase over a period of 18 months beginning with the **June 2022** billing.

Please know we are doing everything we can through our membership in the Louisiana Municipal Gas Authority to ensure you have the lowest natural gas costs as possible.
